94,000 square foot building :: 14 acres :: Ground up

The K-8 school in Houston, Texas located on Orem drive was started 3 weeks after Hurricane Harvey had devastated south Houston area. The tradesmen in the area were anxious to be involved in the project to continue to build up Houston after such a devastating event. Water was constant throughout construction with 1 to 2 rain days a week for the first several months of construction. What had started as a fast-paced energetic project came almost to a halt because of the saturated wet ground conditions. In an effort to keep the project moving forward a “floating walkway” was built on site in the water and mud to allow access from the paved sections of the parking lot to the building pad. This gave us a path to transport material, equipment, and manpower to the building and kept the construction moving. With the use of **CREATIVE** planning our project team was able to complete the project in just over 8 months, despite 48 rains days.
