96,500 square foot building :: 10 Acres :: Ground up

John Adams Academy is a classical K-12 public charter school, located in California. Parkway C&A, LP served as the architect on the project, featuring a campus with design inspiration from American colonial architecture. The 96,501 square foot school was the first John Adams Academy built from the ground up.

The facility consists of administration offices, three (3) libraries, 50 standard classrooms, middle school art classroom, music classroom, gymnasium, athletic training area, high school science classrooms, performance arts area, large lecture hall, one (1) cafeteria with a warming kitchen, and support spaces.

Located in a high seismic area, the stage, gym, and athletic training areas are framed with concrete tilt-walls and long-span steel joists. The remaining structure is framed with structural steel and steel joists.
